

COLOURED HORSE CLASSES

This show is affiliated to The Coloured Horse and Pony Society (UK). *Both the owner and the rider/exhibitor need not be a member of CHAPS (UK) nor must the horse or pony be registered with CHAPS (UK) to compete, but in order to qualify they must both be Showing members and the horse/pony must be registered with the Society BEFORE this show for the qualification to be valid (except Ponies (UK)/BSPS qualifiers where membership and registration, if not already in place, MUST be made within 14 days of qualification for qualification to be valid.) Membership cards and qualification cards must be produced in the ring; the latter being signed by the judge in two places.

These classes are also qualifiers for Ponies UK Summer Championships, please refer to your CHAPS handbook. See CHAPS Members` Handbook or www.chapsuk.com for rulings. The CHAPS (UK) Championship Show will be held on 3rd, 4th and 5th September 2010. Shows held on or after Championship Show will count as 2010 Qualifiers. Members apply in writing to CHAPS (UK) for appropriate qualifier card. Ponies (UK) Summer Championship will be held on the 11th-14th August 2010.

The following classes are CHAPS (UK) Qualifiers 49 -53. For full rulings and information on competition and qualification, please refer to CHAPS (UK) Members' Handbook; or visit www.chapsuk.com.

All stallions entering these classes must be graded with CHAPS (UK). ID cards must be carried in the ring for inspection.

- Class 51** The CHAPS (UK) Non-Native Open In Hand Qualifier.
- Class 52** The CHAPS (UK) Native/Cob/Traditional Open Ridden
- Class 53** The CHAPS (UK) Non-Native Open Ridden Qualifier.
