Special Prizes:

The Walter Winstanley Trophy will be awarded to the Champion of Classes 47 and 48. Class winner rosette will be donated by the Arab Horse Society.

Class 47 Pure Bred Stallion, mare or gelding
To be shown under saddle and judged as a riding horse.

Class 48 Part Bred or Anglo Stallion, mare or gelding
To be shown under saddle and judged as a riding horse. Mixed Height – to qualify One Blue or White card and one Green card. Two may qualify. The highest placed entries within the first four in the class at (a) up to, and including 153cms, and (b) over 153cms will qualify. No entry placed lower than fourth may qualify even if only one height section is covered by top four in the class.

Championship

All horses placed first and second in Classes 47 and 48 are eligible to go forward to the Championship.

ENTRANTS ARE ASKED TO SEND PHOTOCOPIES OF REGISTRATION DOCUMENTS WITH THEIR ENTRY FORMS. WITHOUT THESE, ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED – THIS APPLIES TO ALL ARAB CLASSES
