

## **RIDDEN IRISH DRAUGHT HORSE & IN-HAND CLASSES**

All exhibits must be registered with the Irish Draught Horse Society (GB). Registration/Identification numbers to be **CLEARLY stated on the entry form.**

### **Blue Chip & IDHS (GB) £2,000 Challenge**

The Show is a Qualifier for the **BLUE CHIP & IDHS(GB) £2,000 CHALLENGE.**

The highest placed horse from class 9 will qualify for the Final of the Blue Chip Championship, which will be held at the IDHS (GB) Annual Show on 10<sup>th</sup> & 11<sup>th</sup> September 2011 at Onley Grounds Equestrian Centre. **NB: A horse may only qualify for the final once, regardless of the type or number of classes won, placed in or entered.** Each qualifier will receive a rosette and a £10 voucher from Blue Chip. **Qualifiers are required to complete an online form at [www.idhs.gb.com](http://www.idhs.gb.com) to inform the IDHS(GB) that they have qualified for the final. Following submission of the online form, a qualifiers pack will be sent out, including the £10 Blue Chip Feeds voucher.** In the final, the champion will be awarded £1,000 prize money, a trophy and a Blue Chip rug. The reserve Champion will be awarded £500 and 3<sup>rd</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup> inclusive will be awarded £100 each. Also the highest placed Pure Bred Irish Draught will be awarded a Trophy and £100, the highest placed 15.2 and under will receive £50.

**This show is a Qualifier for the NFU Mutual Irish Draught Youngstock Challenge.** The two highest placed eligible purebreds from each age group (yearling, 2 year old and 3 year old), will qualify to go forward to the final at the IDHS(GB) Annual Breed Show, the details of which are available at [www.idhs.gb.com](http://www.idhs.gb.com)

### **To be eligible for the Final**

- ~ Stock must be registered on the Irish Draught Horse Society (GB) Breed Register
- ~ Stock must be by RID or Class 1 sire out of a graded\* mare
- ~ Two and three year old fillies which have already been inspected and graded Class 1, Class 2 or AID, are eligible to qualify for the final at the Annual Breed Show.

\*A graded mare or filly is one which has been inspected by the IDHS(GB) and passed into one of the following categories: Class1, Class 2, RID, AID, SID or the Supplementary Grading Up Register.

If the highest placed horses in each age group have already qualified, the next eligible horse(s) in the line will qualify.

**Qualifiers are required to complete an online form at [www.idhs.gb.com](http://www.idhs.gb.com) to inform the IDHS(GB) that they have qualified for the final. Following submission of the online form, a qualifiers pack will be sent out direct to the qualifier.**

Mrs JA Kay, Yorkshire - Conformation

Class 7 **Yearling (Colt, Filly or Gelding), Two year old or Three year old, (Filly or Gelding)** by RID or Class 1 sire, out of a graded dam, or graded A mare or filly is one which has been inspected by the IDHS(GB) and passed into one of the

following categories: Class 1, Class 2, RID, AID, SID or the Supplementary Grading Up Register. **Registered on the IDHS(GB) Class. Yearling (Colt, Filly or Gelding), Two year old or Three year old, (Filly or Gelding)** Registered on the Grade 1 Irish Draught Sport Horse Register.

**Class 9 Ridden Irish Draught Pure Bred / Part Bred**  
Open to mares, geldings and stallions, 4 years and over, registered on the IDHS(GB) registers. All Stallions must be in possession of current IDHS(GB) covering certificate book. To be ridden by the Judge.  
This class will be split into two classes, if sufficient entries come forward on the day: -  
a. Irish Draught Horses.  
b. Irish Draught Sports Horses

**Class 10 Irish Draught Show, Ride 'n Jump class**  
**JUMP SPONSORED BY: LAPWING MEWS**  
Mares and Geldings, 4 years and over, Pure bred (RID, AID, SID) and ID Sport Horses. To be registered or identified on the IDHS(GB) Registers.  
**Stage 1 – Conformation and Presentation**  
All exhibitors parade as in-hand show class  
No saddles, boots or bandages  
Maximum Points – Conformation = 20, Presentation = 20  
**Stage 2 – Ride and Jump** – time allowed 2 minutes  
Enter in and salute  
Proceed with individual ride to contain work on both reins and 1 sustained halt (4 secs)  
The two jumps may be taken at any time in the programme and each may only be attempted twice.  
Omitting jumps will forfeit 10 points – (5 points per jump)  
Maximum Points – Paces = 30, Display = 20, Jumping = 10  
  
If sufficient entries class will be split into pure and part-breds.  
Horses not ridden by Judge.

**Entry fees:** Class 7 – 8 £10.00  
Class 9- 10 £14.00

**Prizes:** Class 7 – 8 1<sup>st</sup> - £15, 2<sup>nd</sup> - £12, 3<sup>rd</sup> - £10  
Class 9 – 10 1<sup>st</sup> - £30, 2<sup>nd</sup> - £20, 3<sup>rd</sup> - £15, 4<sup>th</sup> - £10
