## **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

1. Entry forms for all showing classes must be completed by the owner or representative and sent to the Secretary: Miss Stacey Massey, Birchels Gorse, Barleycastle Lane, Appleton, Cheshire, WA4 4RF by the 5th May 2010. Entries on the day will be taken up to Noon (please see schedule for eligible classes). There will be a £5 surcharge for all entries taken on the day.
2. **ALL SHOWJUMPING ENTRIES ON THE DAY ONLY – BRITISH SHOWJUMPING AND UNAFFILIATED**
3. Cheques must be payable to the Warrington Horse Society. **ALL COMPETITOR NUMBERS TO BE COLLECTED ON SHOW DAY**
4. Owners may enter as many horses as they wish, and all competitors are open unless stated otherwise in the schedule.
5. Entries will **NOT BE ACCEPTED** unless accompanied by the correct fees (and must include first aid tariff of £3 per competitor).
6. In the event of a horse or pony being unable to compete through illness, accident or the like, the Society will refund the whole of the entry fee on production of a Veterinary Certificate, (except in the case of British Showjumping showjumpers, which are provided for under British Showjumping rules – please refer to British Showjumping rule book).
7. Exhibitor's boxes and Exhibits must stand in the space allocated for their purposes. The Society will strictly enforce this condition.
8. Entries to be on showground half an hour before judging.
9. **ALL PRIZE MONEY MUST BE COLLECTED ON THE DAY OF THE SHOW OTHERWISE IT WILL BE FORFEITED.** No prize money will be given out without production of the Exhibitors number, rosette and class number. Prize money will be awarded once results received by Treasurer.
10. All trophies must be returned to the Secretary in good condition at least one month prior to the date of the next Show.
11. **ALL RIDDEN CLASS COMPETITORS** must wear a hard hat to the current BS and EU standard unless they are competing in Class 43 and 46 or 134 – 139 and have signed a Hat Waiver Form (on back of entry form)
12. It is recommended that competitors involved in jumping wear a body protector of the appropriate BS and EU standard.
13. A levy of £3.00 will be charged per competitor towards the cost of First Aid provision.
14. In Light horse classes, any class with less than six entries, prize money will be awarded to 1st and 2nd places only. Rosettes to 5th place will be awarded.

The Show is a Qualifier for the BLUE CHIP & IDHS(GB) £2,000 CHALLENGE. The highest placed Purebred and highest placed Partbred from class 12 will qualify for the Final of the Blue Chip Championship, which will be held at the IDHS(GB) Annual show on (date and venue to be announced). NB: A horse may only qualify for the final once, regardless of type or number of class won, placed in or entered. Each qualifier will receive a rosette and a £10 voucher from Blue Chip. In the final, the Champion will be awarded £1,000 prize money, a trophy and a Blue Chip rug. The Reserve Champion will be awarded £500 and 3rd to 7th inclusive will be awarded £100 each. Also the highest placed Pure Bred Irish Draught will be awarded a Trophy and £100, the highest placed 15.2 and under will receive £50.

### **Class 13 Irish Draught Show, Ride 'n Jump Class**

Mares and Geldings, 4 years and over, Pure bred (RID, AID, SID) and ID Sport Horses. To be registered or identified on the IDHS(GB) Registers.

Stage 1 – Conformation and Presentation

All exhibitors parade as in-hand show class

No saddles, boots or bandages

Maximum Points – Conformation = 20, Presentation = 20

Stage 2 – Ride and Jump – time allowed 2 minutes

Enter in and salute. Proceed with individual ride to contain work on both reins and 1 sustained halt (4 secs). The two jumps may be taken at any time in the programme and each may only be attempted twice. Omitting jumps will forfeit 10 points – (5 points per jump). Maximum Points – Paces = 30, Display = 20, Jumping = 10

If sufficient entries class will be split into pure and part-breds.

Horses not ridden by Judge.

**RIDDEN SHOW HUNTER HORSE CLASSES**  
**SPONSORED BY: MR MARK FITTON, NEW HILL STUD**

This show is affiliated to the Sport Horse Breeding (GB). All horses must be on the basic register of SHB (GB) for classes 14 and 15. Classes 15 – 18 Riders and owners must be members of Sport horse (GB) and all horses also have to be on 2010(SHB(GB)) show hunter register. Classes 15 -18 are RIHS qualifiers (entries will include an RIHS levy of £7.50) and the first two in each class will qualify. Classes 15-18 are National Hunter Supreme Championship (NHSCS) qualifiers. The first three to qualify. Riders and owners must be members of SHB (GB) and all horses must be on the 2010 SHB (GB) Show Hunter register.

This show is affiliated to Ponies Association (UK): Affiliation Number 010/AFF/6113. Classes 15-18 are qualifiers for P(UK) Championship show The Ponies (UK) Whittakers Lord Open Hunter of the Year Championship for classes 16 - 18. 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize winners will qualify.

The Brineton Small Hunter Championships for class 15, 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize winners will qualify.

This show is affiliated to the NCPA affiliation no: 103/10 and is a qualifier for the NCPA Pony of the Year Show and the Part Bred Welsh Ridden Championships to be held in conjunction with the Pony of the Year Show at Warren Farm Equestrian Centre, Formby, Merseyside L37 0AN on 4th & 5th September 2010. 1st & 2nd prizewinners in class 11 will qualify and highest not qualified in the first 6 for Part Bred Welsh in appropriate classes.

**Blue Chip & IDHS (GB) £2,000 Challenge**

This show is a qualifier for the Blue Chip & IDHS (GB) £2,000 Challenge. The highest placed horse (not already qualified) in each of the following (class 14 - 18) will qualify for the Final of the Blue Chip and IDHS (GB) championship, which will be held at the IDHS (GB) Annual Breed Show.

A Horse may only qualify for the final once, regardless of type or number of classes won, placed in or entered. Each Qualifier will receive a rosette and a voucher for £10 from Blue Chip. In the final the champion will be awarded £1,000 prize money plus a Blue Chip Rug, the Reserve Champion will be awarded £500 and 3rd to 7th inclusive will be awarded £100 each. In addition, the highest placed pure bred will receive a trophy and £100 each and the highest placed 15.2hh and under will receive a Trophy and £50.

**Special Prizes:**

A special rosette will be awarded by the IDHS (GB) to the highest placed pure or part bred Irish Draught Horse in Classes 14 and 15. Exhibits must be registered or identified with the IDHS (GB) on either their Pure bred or Sport Horse register. The Lord Daresbury Perpetual Challenge Cup will be awarded to the champion Hunter in the Championship.

**Class 14 Novice Hunters - NCPA Qualifier**

Mare or gelding 4 years or over not having awarded a first prize value of £60 or total of £200 (or equivalent values) in any SHB(GB) affiliated Ridden Hunter Classes at home or abroad before 1st January in current year, excepting all prize money awarded as a four year old. Any horse that qualifies will not be eligible to compete in Novice classes from 1st January the following year but horses that qualified for HOYS as a 4 year old are exempt.

**Class 15 Small Hunter Class**

Mare or gelding 4 years or over, exceeding 148cms but not to exceed 158cms. Riders to have attained their 16th birthday by 1st January in the current year

**Class 16 Lightweight Hunter Class:**

Mare or gelding 4 years or over, capable of carrying up to 12.7 stone.  
Riders to have attained their 16th birthday by 1st January in the current year.

**Class 17 Middleweight Hunter Class**

Mare or gelding, 4years old and over, capable of carrying 12.7 stone but not 14 stone.  
Riders to have attained 16th birthday by 1st January in the current year.

**Class 18 Heavyweight Hunter Class**

Mare or gelding 4 years and over and capable of carrying over 14 stone. Riders to have attained their 16th birthday by 1st January in the current year.
