#### **Blue Chip & IDHS (GB) £2,000 Challenge**

The Show is a Qualifier for the **BLUE CHIP & IDHS(GB) £2,000 CHALLENGE.**

The highest placed horse from class 9 will qualify for the Final of the Blue Chip Championship, which will be held at the IDHS (GB) Annual Show on 10<sup>th</sup> & 11<sup>th</sup> September 2011 at Onley Grounds Equestrian Centre. **NB: A horse may only qualify for the final once, regardless of the type or number of classes won, placed in or entered.** Each qualifier will receive a rosette and a £10 voucher from Blue Chip. **Qualifiers are required to complete an online form at [www.idhs.gb.com](http://www.idhs.gb.com) to inform the IDHS(GB) that they have qualified for the final. Following submission of the online form, a qualifiers pack will be sent out, including the £10 Blue Chip Feeds voucher.** In the final, the champion will be awarded £1,000 prize money, a trophy and a Blue Chip rug. The reserve Champion will be awarded £500 and 3<sup>rd</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup> inclusive will be awarded £100 each. Classes 11 – 17 Riders and owners must be members of Sport horse (GB) and all horses also have to be on 2011(SHB(GB)) show hunter register. Classes 12 -17 are RIHS qualifiers (entries will include an RIHS levy of £8.00) and the first two in each class will qualify. Classes 12-17 are National Hunter Supreme Championship (NHSCS) qualifiers. The first three to qualify. **Riders and owners must be members of SHB (GB) and all horses must be on the 2011 SHB (GB) Show Hunter register.**

Classes 12-15 are qualifiers for P(UK) Championship show

The Ponies (UK) Whittakers Lord Open Hunter of the Year Championship for classes 13 - 15. 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> prize winners will qualify.

The Brineton Small Hunter Championships for class 12, 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> prize winners will qualify.

**A Horse may only qualify for the final once, regardless of type or number of classes won, placed in or entered.**

**Each** Qualifier will receive a rosette and a voucher for £10 from Blue Chip. In the final the champion will be awarded £1,000 prize money plus a Blue Chip Rug, the Reserve Champion will be awarded £500 and 3<sup>rd</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup> inclusive will be awarded £100 each. In addition, the highest placed pure bred will receive a trophy and £100 each and the highest placed 15.2hh and under will receive a Trophy and £50.

 Mare or gelding 4 years or over, capable of carrying up to 12.7 stone. Riders to have attained their 16<sup>th</sup> birthday by 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year.
- Class 14      **Middleweight Hunter Class**  
 Mare or gelding, 4years old and over, capable of carrying 12.7 stone but not 14 stone. Riders to have attained 16th birthday by 1st January in the current year.
- Class 15      **Heavyweight Hunter Class**  
 Mare or gelding 4 years and over and capable of carrying over 14 stone. Riders to have attained their 16th birthday by 1st January in the current year.
- Class 16      **Amateur Ridden Hunter – Lightweight Class**  
 Mare or Gelding, 4 years old or over, capable of carrying 12.7 stone and under. **Small Hunters to be included in this category.**
- Class 17      **Amateur Ridden Hunter – Heavyweight Class**  
 Mare or Gelding, 4 years old or over, capable of carrying over 12.7 stone. **Middleweight Hunters to be included in this category.**
